



BritInn Fellowship Programme - OUTGOING

Through the “BritInn Fellowship Programme”, BritInn supports University of Innsbruck academic staff members of all disciplines – especially early career researchers - to spend time at a university or research institution in Great Britain to promote collaboration and engage in joint research projects.

BritInn Fellows devote their time at the host institution to do research and to work on a joint project with colleagues from Great Britain. BritInn will cover travel and/or living costs, depending upon the quality of the application.

Applications can be made directly to BritInn.

The BritInn Fellow is expected to be in residence at the host institution for the duration of the stay. BritInn Fellows are expected to give a public guest lecture at the host institution about their research.

This program should further promote the academic exchange, enhance the visibility of outstanding scholars from the University of Innsbruck in Great Britain and especially enhance further long-lasting future collaborations.

Requirements:

- Doctorate/PhD
- Employment the University of Innsbruck
- Outstanding academic merit
- Time of stay: during the regular semester at the host institution
- A public presentation about the research of the BritInn Fellow at the host institution
- Statement that no other funding opportunities are available (see application form)
- Length of stay: up to a maximum of 2 weeks

- CV and list of publications

- Outline of joint research project between the outgoing BritInn Fellow and the host department and an outline of the public lecture/presentation of the research

Deadline for applications:

31 October 2018 (for the academic year 2018/2019)
