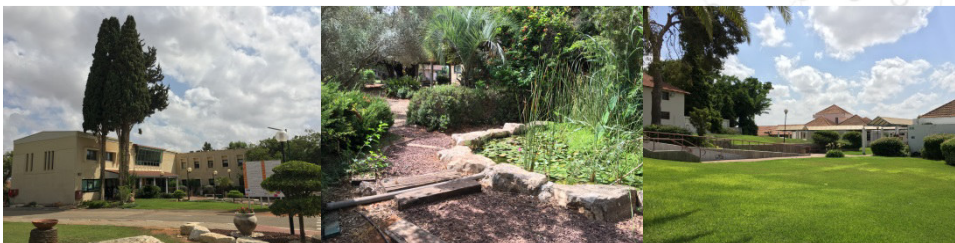
NEW! Erasmus+ scholarships to study at Beit Berl College (Israel) during the Winter Semester 2017/2018 or Summer Semester 2018

The EU offers scholarships for BA, MA and PhD students from the University of Innsbruck to study at **Beit Berl College in Israel** within the Erasmus+ Mobility Program. Interested students can apply until **May 10, 2017** for the Winter Semester 2017/2018 (October 2017-February 2018) and until **July 1, 2017** for the Summer Semester 2018. There are limited spots available. Students will not pay any tuition at the host institution and will get a monthly scholarship for the duration of the exchange program.

Studying at Beit Berl College (Israel)

Beit Berl College (BBC) is a multidisciplinary college focused on training educators while spearheading new developments in education, society and the arts. BBC was founded in 1949 and is one of the largest colleges in Israel, with more than 10,000 students and 700 faculty members. It includes the Faculty of Education, Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Society and Culture. BBC is a multicultural campus with a diverse mixture of students and faculty. It was the first college to be recognized for academic excellence and gain the same academic independence as Israeli's universities. It has a high focus on community engagement.

The campus is located at the meeting point between one of Israel's high-tech centers (Kfar Saba and Raanana) and the Triangle region of Israel's Arab towns (Tira and Taibeh), approx. 30 minutes from Tel Aviv.

Length of Scholarship: 5 months for one semester

Amount of Scholarship: 650 Euros per month plus travel allowance (360 Euros)

Language of Instruction: Hebrew and English (selected courses)

Requirements:

- Registered student at the University of Innsbruck in one of the above mentioned study programs; all cycles (BA, MA, Diplom., PhD, Doktorat)
- English B1 is mandatory; Hebrew is not mandatory, but basic knowledge is highly encouraged (courses are offered again through the ISI in the Wintersemester 2017/2018)
- Application Form, CV, letter of motivation, transcript, etc. (complete list see below)
- Signed Learning Agreement by the Erasmus+ Coordinator or StudiendekanIn; at least 30 ECTS must be obtained at the receiving institution

Documents Required:

- Application Form, please download here: www.aiani.at/erasmus-outgoing
- CV written in English
- Transcript of Records ("Studienerfolgsnachweis") in English with **ALL exams** (also with negative grades) listed
- Letter of Motivation, stating why the student wants to participate in this exchange program and why he/she should be selected for the scholarship
- PhD students should also submit a Letter of Invitation from a faculty member at BBC who agrees to supervise the student (the PhD students are responsible for getting in contact with a faculty at BBC) and a draft/abstract of the dissertation project
- Copy of Passport [Please note. Your passport must be valid at least six months longer than your projected stay will last]
- Language Certificate in English level B1 (if available)

Student Selection:

After the deadline, all applicants will be ranked according to academic merit, letter of motivation and financial means. Selected students might additionally be invited for an interview. All students will get a response about their application.

Also needed for the exchange semester (exact guidelines will be given out after the first approval):

- Valid passport (at least six months longer than the stay will last)
- All necessary documents for a visa application
- Health/travel insurance
- Proof of accommodation

Application Deadline: May 10, 2017
